

LAGOON CUSTOM

Although the design does not follow the styling DNA of the Lagoon production range, this new design has similar attributes: large volume, flexible interior layouts, and a variety of recreational spaces coupled with good performance.

The two features we identified as important for the design are a full width owner's cabin on the main deck, and a separate internal pilot position.

The owner's cabin had to have its own secure cockpit, a cabin that utilises all the hull volume, however without too many stairs. To achieve this, we designed a high side deck and freeboard forward, allowing deep hull windows that work from the bridge deck and the hulls.

For charter, the accommodation allows for up to five equal-size guest cabins, all with large ensuite facilities. Crew and galley are situated separately in one hull, as well as a dedicated crew mess and laundry, both important features for the smooth running of a busy charter boat.

The aft deck and swim platform are designed to create a large, water-focussed leisure area. The tender is carried on a platform that is lowered for launching. The platform then becomes a "beach" for water sports and swimming, as an extension of the hull platforms.
